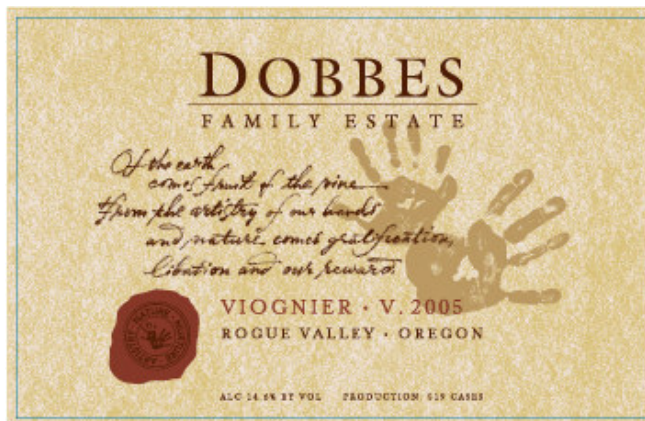




HIGHLY RECOMMENDED



Intricate and abundant aromas of hay, peach, anise, and dried potpourri are full and satisfying on the nose. A similar complexity appears on the palate: mouth-filling flavors of peach, apricot, and fig are framed by a light toasty edge. Despite the sense of mass to the flavors, there is bright acidity and an overall fresh feel. Concentrated on the mid-palate, the wine finishes full and fruity with an added sense of minerality. Despite its “bigness,” this is a controlled wine. Enjoy with monkfish romanesco.
