



DOBBES FAMILY ESTATE 2012 Meyer Vineyard Pinot Noir | Dundee Hills AVA

Sensory Components & Tasting Notes

Color: Deep Garnet

Aroma: Ripe red fruits, dark cherry, complex-subtle toasted oak

Mouthfeel: Medium body, smooth tannins with supporting acid

Flavor: Wild strawberry, red currant, caramel, dark chocolate

Finish: Medium length carried by acid

Complex aroma shows more of the subtle oak as fresh fruit gives way to ripe strawberry jam and floral red currant. A small amount of second fill French oak provides a surprising amount of complexity found in toffee, chocolate, anise and a touch of caramel. The palate reflects the aroma and opens to smooth tannins, medium body and acid that supports the moderate structure. Coming from the warm, sun kissed 2012 vintage, the finish is medium in length with fine grain tannins and elegant acid.
