



# DOBBES FAMILY ESTATE 2012 Quailhurst Vineyard Pinot Noir | Chehalem Mountains AVA

## Sensory Components & Tasting Notes

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**Color:** Deep Ruby

**Aroma:** Strawberry, spicy oak complexity, dried cherry, red currant

**Mouthfeel:** Smooth entry, full body, structured mid-palate, bright acid

**Flavor:** Ripe red berries, red plum, pomegranate, complex notes of pipe tobacco, dried herb, vanilla

**Finish:** Full body, structured tannins, bright acid

*Opulent strawberry, dried cherry and fresh red currant aromas are matched with complex spicy oak characters of vanilla and graham cracker along with subtle cardamom, star anise and floral rosehips. The palate, like the aroma, has diverse fruit characters of red plum, strawberry preserves, cranberry and raspberry. Oak flavors of vanilla pipe tobacco and cedar play well with notes of sweet dried herbs. A full bodied entry is framed with structured tannins that carry through a long, bright acid finish. Within a warm, early drinking vintage this wine has the intensity and structure for continued bottle aging; enjoy now through 2017.*
