## 2013 EOLA-AMITY CUVÉE PINOT NOIR *Eola-Amity Hills AVA*

### GROWING SEASON

2013 was the driest year since 1985, until the final week of September when Oregon received the remnants of a typhoon that hit Japan. While the last-minute rain presented its challenges, this vintage has delicate layers of complex fruit; a true expression from the Eola-Amity Hills AVA.

### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

It's hard to express the beauty of the Eola-Amity Hills AVA through words. So instead, I made this wine. Symonette is sourced for 50% of the blend with Roserock and Willakia composing the other half in roughly equal parts. I love working with grapes from this region, where rolling hills provide ample opportunity for diverse vineyard sites and excellent blending components.
