Sensory Components & Tasting Notes

Color: Purple garnet

Aroma: Ripe red berries, nutmeg, rose and cocoa

Mouth Feel: Medium body with lean tannins

Flavor: Raspberry, pomegranate with oaky cocoa and nutmeg

Finish: Long

Purple-garnet with aromas of pie-cherry and marionberry along with floral rose and oaky nutmeg and cocoa. The palate is framed in structured tannins wrapped with medium bodied, red-fruited raspberry and pomegranate along with complex, oaky vanilla and spice. A long finish is carried by a clean acid backbone. Stylistically opulent, this luxurious wine is rich, full bodied and will age gracefully.
