



2012 | Oregon Pinot Noir



Grapes for this 2012 Pinot Noir were hand-picked at peak maturity from select vineyards located in Oregon's Willamette Valley AVA. At the winery, fruit from each vineyard was separately fermented, pressed, aged in French Oak barrels and then blended. Our 2012 Pinot Noir has yielded elegant, approachable tannins, ripe berry fruit flavors and complex aromas of dried and preserved fruits. A wine born from a naturally balanced harvesting season, this Pinot is ready to drink and does not require the cellar time of less ripe vintages.
