



2013 | Oregon Pinot Gris



Classic Oregon Pinot Gris aromas of pear and green apple are balanced with ripe, floral peach and banana. Zesty lemon peel, green mango and apple keep the palate crisp and light with a long finish while ripe Asian pear and honey flavors fill the mid-palate and balance body. Stainless steel fermentation at cool temperatures focus the aromas and flavors of this multi-vineyard blend of Pinot Gris on bright fruit that represents Oregon's Willamette Valley and the 2013 vintage.
