

## PINOT GRIS 2013

Floral complexity leads the aroma supported by lemon, pineapple, white peach, pear and yellow apple. Crisp, light and dry the palate is full of mouth-watering, juicy green apple, cumquat and honeydew melon. Stainless steel fermentation and an early bottling date keep this multi-vineyard blend fresh and fruit driven, crisp acid lengthens the finish making for an excellent glass of wine before dinner or with lighter meals.
