

## PINOT NOIR 2012

Dark garnet color, moderate tannins and alcohol with complex fruit and earth characters showcase this wine as classic Oregon Pinot Noir. Dark cherry and bright raspberry fruit is balanced with subtle earth all accented with elegant rose. A full body framed with medium tannins and clean acid leads to a medium-long finish full of tart cherry and hints of toasted oak.

**Aroma:** Dried cherry, raspberry, roses & lilies, earthy-tobacco and dried leaves

**Mouth Feel:** Medium entry and full mid-palate

**Flavor:** Dusty tannins, tart cherry and rhubarb, subtle toffee and cocoa

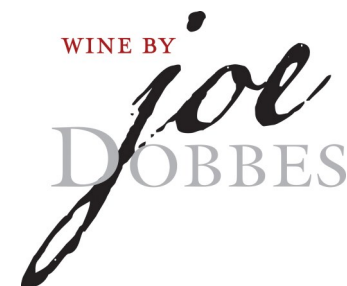
