Sensory Components & Tasting Notes

Color: Brick red

Aroma: Fruit dominant with complex oak

Mouth Feel: Medium body with structure

Flavor: Diverse, bright red fruits, supportive oak, firm tannins

Finish: Medium long with tannin

This wine highlights fruit just up the hill from Arcus Vineyard. Abundant bright fruit leads the aroma with strawberry and cherry highlighted by classic Dundee Hills characters of pomegranate and rose. The palate expresses rich tannin, more red fruit and oak characters of cedar, nutmeg, and toffee. Assertive and bright as a young wine, it will evolve into an even more rewarding wine with age.
