Sensory Components & Tasting Notes

Color: Medium ruby-garnet

Aroma: Complex cherry, red rose, pomegranate, black currant, barrel spice

Mouth Feel: Medium-light, structured tannins

Flavor: Raspberry, cranberry, pomegranate, light toasted oak

Finish: Long

Complex aromas of floral rose, black currant and cherry intermingle with integrated toasted oak. On the palate, tart acid leads the entry and lengthens the finish filled in with medium body and moderate structured tannins. Flavors of juicy raspberry, mouth-watering cranberry and oaky vanilla transition into black fruited accents. Overall, a more complex version of Meyer with darker fruits and support from structured skin tannins. 25% new oak fills in the seams and adds layers without overwhelming the fruit.
