Ripe red fruits dominate the aroma and flavor, leading with sun-warmed strawberry, bing cherries and red currant. The palate deftly balances acid and tannin supported by plush medium-full body. Subtle accents of red rose, pie crust and vanilla lend complexity to this fruit forward Pinot Noir that represents the elegance of the 2013 vintage.

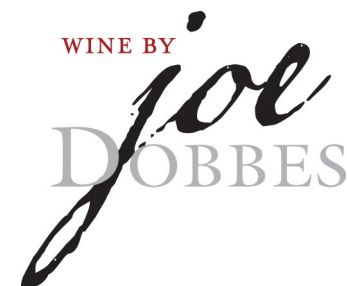
