



DOBBES FAMILY ESTATE 2014 Grand Assemblage Pinot Noir | Willamette Valley

Sensory Components & Tasting Notes

Color: Bright garnet

Aroma: Bold, red, berry fruits, subtle vanilla, rose and tobacco spice

Mouthfeel: Medium body, fine tannins, fresh acid

Flavor: Fresh raspberry, cranberry and pomegranate, support from red currant and cherry

Finish: Medium-long, moderate tannins carried by acid

Bright, fresh, red-berry fruit drives the aroma and flavor. Intriguing complex notes of spice, vanilla, tobacco and floral rose are found throughout. Moderate tannins, medium body and vibrant acid keep the palate lively though the medium-long finish. As an eight vineyard blend, represented by five growing regions in the Willamette Valley this wine makes a bold statement to the fruit driven nature of the 2014 vintage.
