



2015 WINE BY JOE ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

Technical Details: An alluring rose quartz winks from the glass of this saignée-based Pinot Noir rosé. Floral driven aromas abound with jasmine and hibiscus pleasantly balanced by stone fruit and strawberry. The palate is clean and fresh with elegant apricot and bubble gum floral notes and light-red fruit accents. A full body and lengthening acid supports the finish. This is a delicate and pretty rosé that easily pairs with a variety of dishes or simply sipped on its own.
