



## 2014 | Oregon Pinot Gris



*Blending multiple vineyards keeps this classic style of Oregon Pinot Gris representative of the Willamette Valley and the 2014 vintage. Stainless steel fermentation at cool temperatures provides fresh fruit aromas of pear and apple woven with floral honeysuckle and lemongrass. The palate has a dry entry transitioning to medium body with bright flavors of preserved lemon and citrus zest and rounded flavors of ripe pear and almond. The palate draws to a close with juicy acid and medium body carrying a medium long finish.*

### SENSORY COMPONENTS:

*Color:* Light straw

*Aroma:* Apple, honeysuckle, lemongrass, pear

*Mouthfeel:* Dry, medium body, lively acidity

*Flavor:* Preserved lemon, ripe pear, citrus zest, almond

*Finish:* Medium long with juicy acid
