




2014 WINE BY JOE PINOT GRIS



Color: Light straw

Aroma: White peach, honeydew melon, banana, pear, guava

Mouthfeel: Light entry, medium-full mid palate, mouthwatering acid

Flavor: Dried pears, citrus zest

Finish: Dry, medium weight, crisp acid

Appellation: Willamette Valley

Barrel Aging: 100% stainless steel

TA: 5.5 g/L

pH: 3.18

Alcohol level: 13.5%

Bottle Date: March 5, 2015

Food Pairing: Pasta with grilled chicken

Technical Details: Primarily a four vineyard blend, this Willamette Valley Pinot Gris opens with aromas of white peach, melon and notes of soft tropical fruit. Dry on the palate with medium body and fruit characters of dried pears and citrus zest. Crisp acidity integrates well with medium body to make a smooth finish accented with mouthwatering acid.
