



## 2014 | Oregon Pinot Noir



*Opens with aromas of cheerful, bright red fruit, hibiscus petal and hints of baking spice and nutmeg. This Pinot Noir has lively acidity and exhibits flavors of pomegranate, red currant, strawberry and vanilla. A warm growing season with high quality fruit provides a soft entry, silky mouth feel, and boasts a flavorful combination of red fruit, cola and oak. Expressive and bright throughout the palate, this wine has a medium-long, mouthwatering acid finish, boding well for a food-friendly wine.*
