## 2014 | Pinot Noir

Aromas of bright cherry and strawberry along with dark marionberry lead, followed by earthy accents of black licorice and pepper. The palate opens with young tannins, tart and candied cherries and bright acid, transitioning to medium-full body and a finish carried by both juicy acid and structured tannins.

*Appellation:* Willamette Valley

*Bottle Date:* August 2016

*Barrel Aging:* 9 months, 100% oak barrels

*Alcohol Level:* 13.5%

*TA:* 6.80 g/L

*pH:* 3.45



## 2015 | Pinot Gris

Blending multiple vineyards keeps this classic style of Oregon Pinot Gris representative of the Willamette Valley and the 2015 vintage. Stainless steel fermentation at cool temperatures provides fresh fruit aromas of pear and apple woven with floral honeysuckle and lemongrass. The palate has a dry entry transitioning to medium body with bright flavors of preserved lemon and citrus zest and rounded flavors of ripe pear and almond. The palate draws to a close with juicy acid and medium body carrying a medium long finish.

*Barrel Aging:* 100% Stainless steel

*pH:* 5.60
