



2015 | Willamette Valley Pinot Noir



A complex bouquet swirls from the glass, rich with strawberry, candied cherry and ripe blueberries, accented with floral pomegranate and rose, spiced with toasted oak characters of cedar, chocolate and tobacco. The mouthfeel has a full entry with a juicy mid-palate and sweet oak accents. Flavors are complex with tart raspberry and wild strawberry, mingling with preserved cherries and spicy oak found in vanilla, cedar and sweet tobacco. This wine has a medium length finish with fresh acid and youthful tannins.

SENSORY COMPONENTS:

Color: Garnet

Aroma: Floral, strawberry, blueberry, cherry, pomegranate, cranberry, toasted oak

Mouthfeel: Medium-full body, juicy, moderate tannins

Flavor: Candied cherry, wild strawberry, tart raspberry and oak spice

Finish: Medium length, medium acid, fine-grain tannins
